


Identity and Access Management (IAM) Engineer





Governance and Compliance Analysts





Why volatility (Analyst, DevSecops, SecEng, IAM)


- Analyst: largest teams, can consolidate roles easier
- DevSecops: Result of digitalization (covid)
 - Hard to find these professionals, not many of them.
 - New Industry trend, shift left material in job postings, is it in practice?
- Security Engineering
 - Second largest team, can consolidate roles easier.
- IAM
 - Large push to digitalization pre-pandemic, so why?

- Jobs data shows that compliance trumps security

- Posted Jobs are not all approved
 - Example: Amazon 25,000 posted jobs in 2022, only 7,800 approved
 - 17,200 Posted Not Approved
- Job Descriptions do not make sense so people have to apply to all jobs
- Job searching and hiring are more broken than ever
